3. Explain the difference between the sample group and the control group.

4. Talk about the results (no effect → success).

5. Say what happened then (other scientists). Why? (breakthrough)

6. Explain:

- **what** Andre's boss did ("humanitarian" action):
- **how** Andre reacted ("laugh");
- **why** Andre reacted this way.



7. Say **what** Andre decided to do and **why**.

8. Your opinion: talk about one or both of the following topics.

a. Do you think Andre is a traitor?

b. What do you think should be done to fight against AIDS?
